After a short ride our first stop will be at The Falklands Arms in Great Tew. This is a beautiful 16th Century building.

The landlady 'Kate' has kindly agreed to open the pub for a coffee/tea and a bacon roll. Coffee or Tea £1.75 Bacon Roll £4.50. If you'd like a bacon roll can you please let us know in advance or on the morning of the ride out.

We anticipate staying here for about 30–40 mins.

Our journey will then continue to Adam Henson's Cotswold Farm Park at Guiting Power. The Park is part of the 650 hectare Bemborough Farm, high on the Cotswold hills. It's the home of the Rare Breeds Conservation Trust. Adam is famous for his appearances on the BBC Series Countryfile.

On arriving at the Farm Park you may use the facilities which includes Adams kitchen, which serves hot/cold food and drinks. There are tables and grass banks for picnics if you prefer to cater for yourselves. Let's hope the sun shines for us!

If you wish to go and see the Rare Breeds the price for a Standard adult is £ 8.50, and £7.95 for seniors. There are concessions for large groups. We will need to let the Farm Park know the numbers for parking.
