










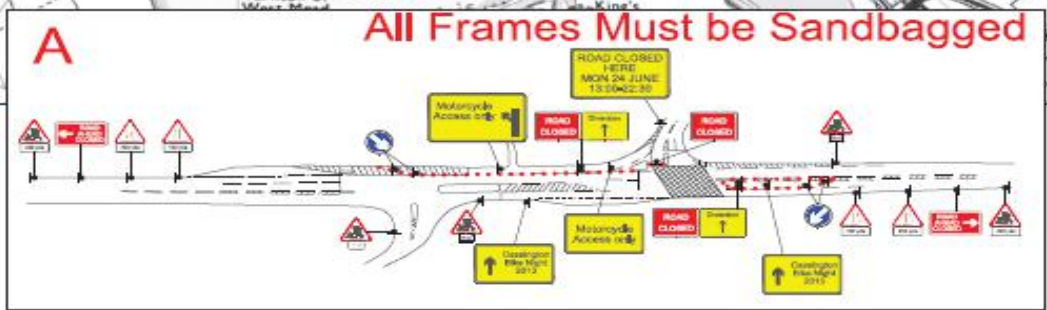
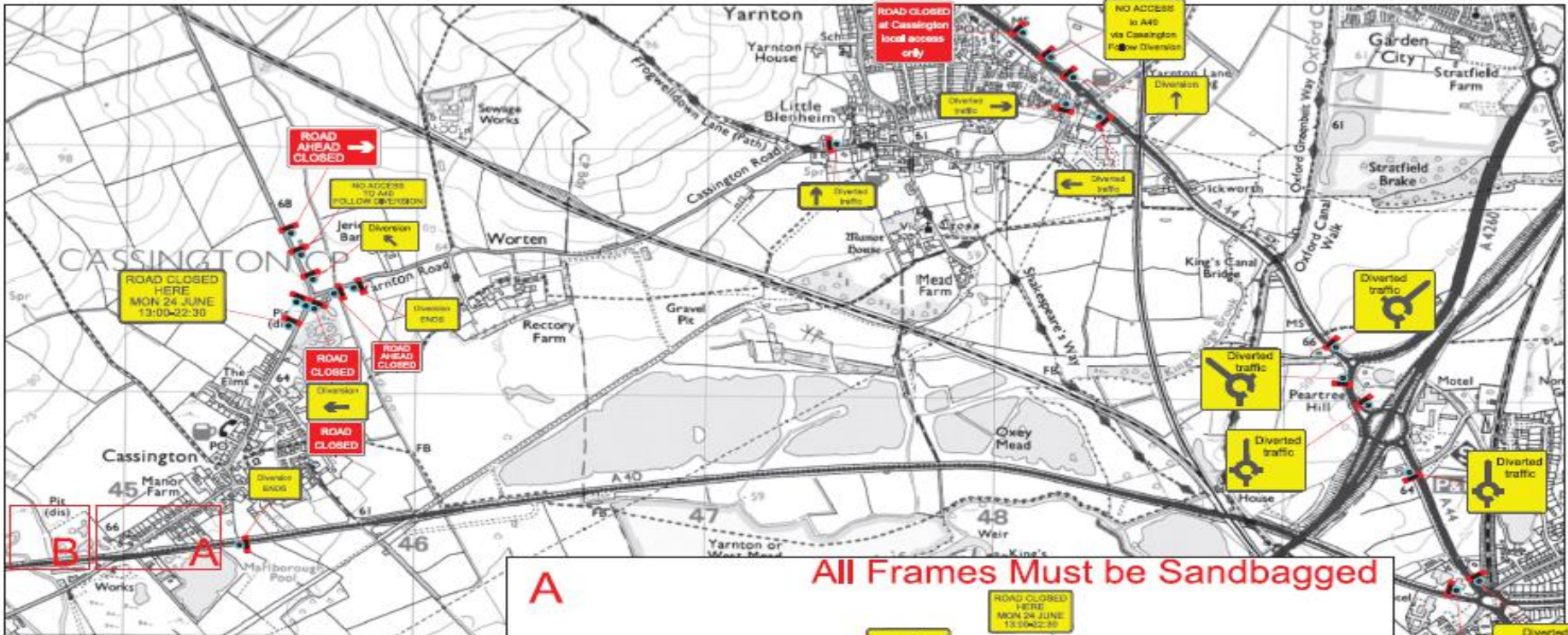

# TRAFFIC PLAN – ROAD CLOSURE

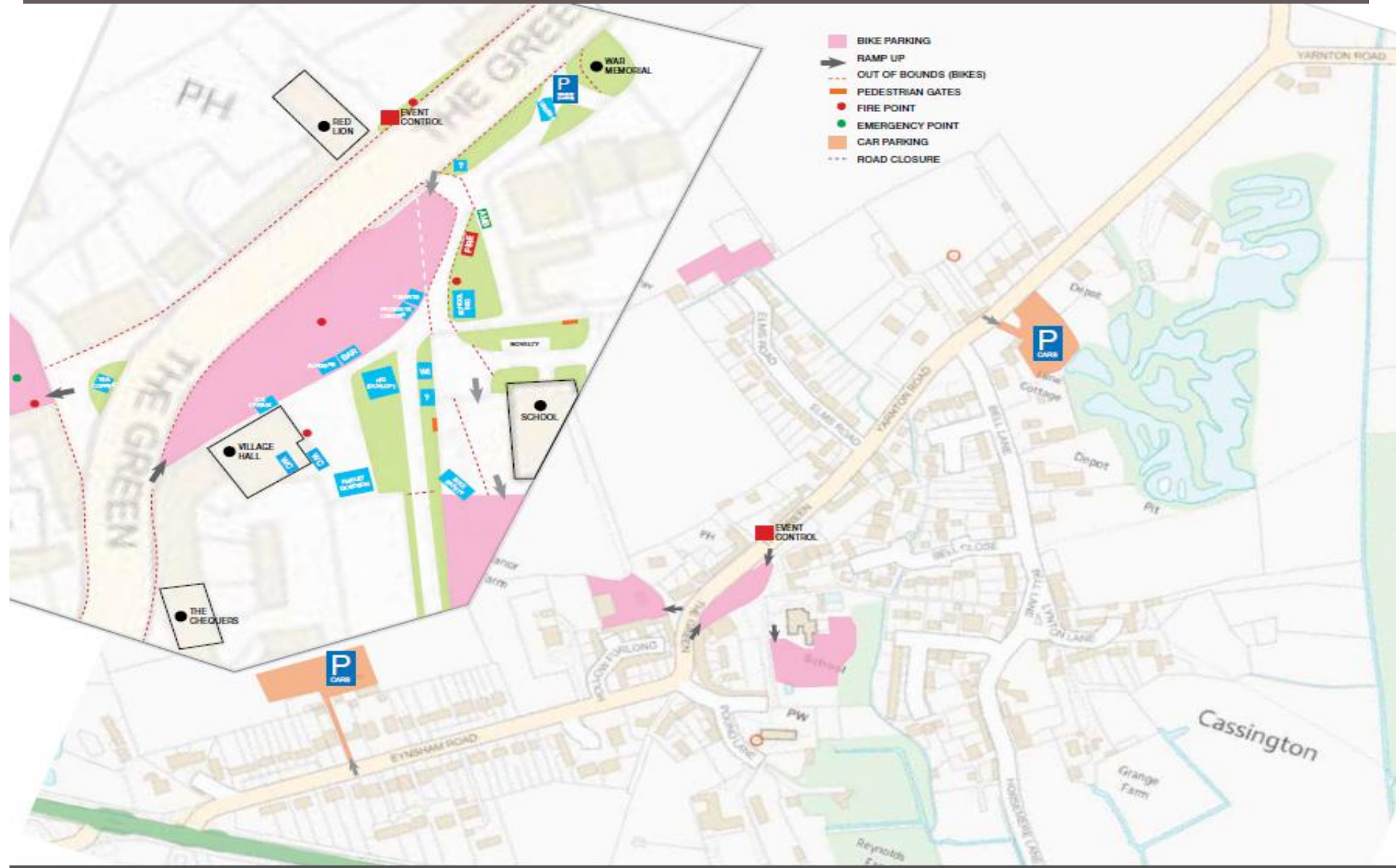
-  We plan to use a TPCA road closure granted by West Oxford District Council
-  The County have offered to provide Road Closure Signs
-  The closure will be enforced between 13:00 and 23:00 on the 30<sup>th</sup> June
-  The road closure will be operated by 4 marshals (2 at each end).
-  Signage detailing the planned road closure times will be erected one week in advance of the event
-  The committee will leaflet drop the village informing them of the event and planned road closure one week before the event
-  Full Details of the planned road closure will be published in the June Cassington News Letter

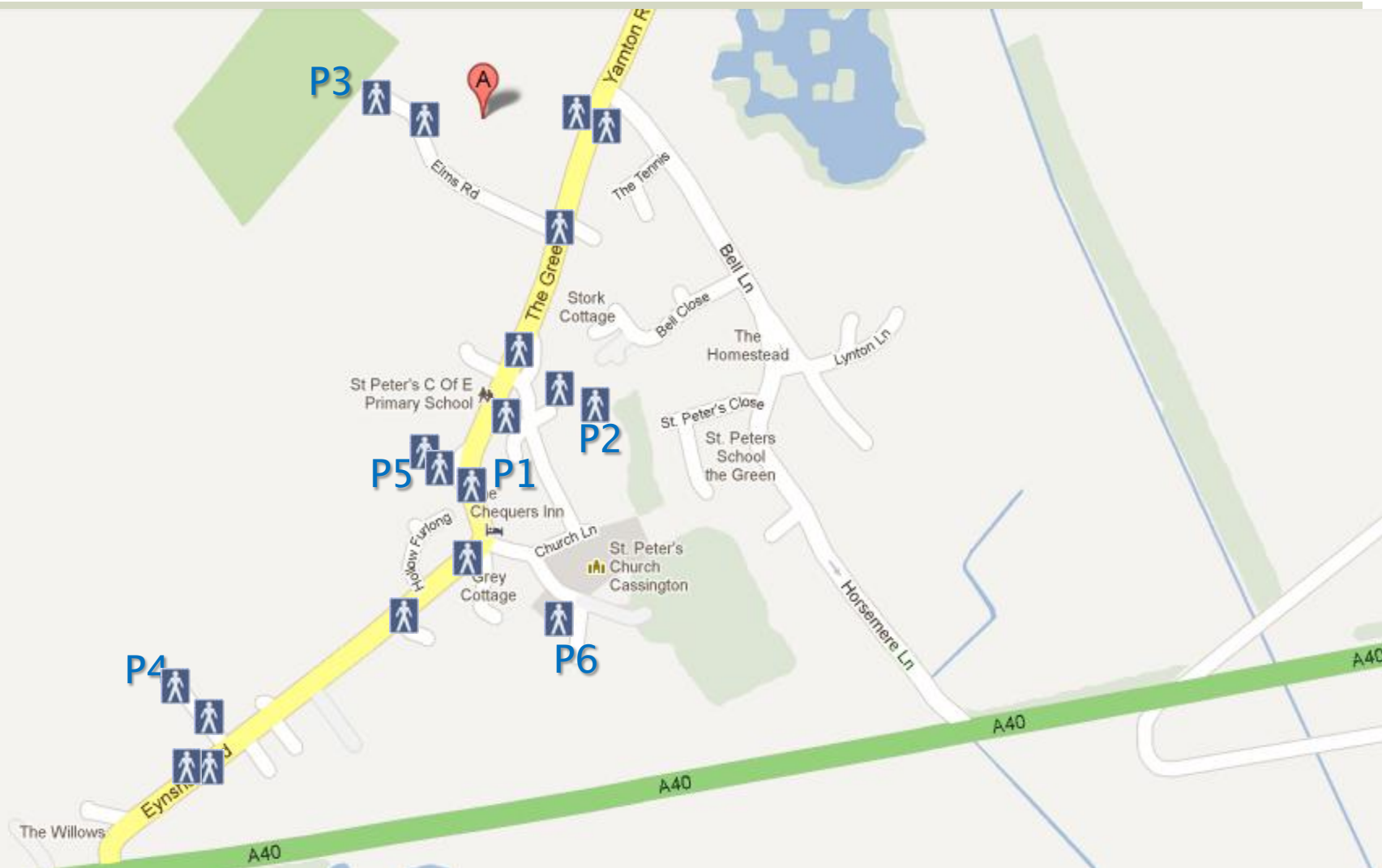
